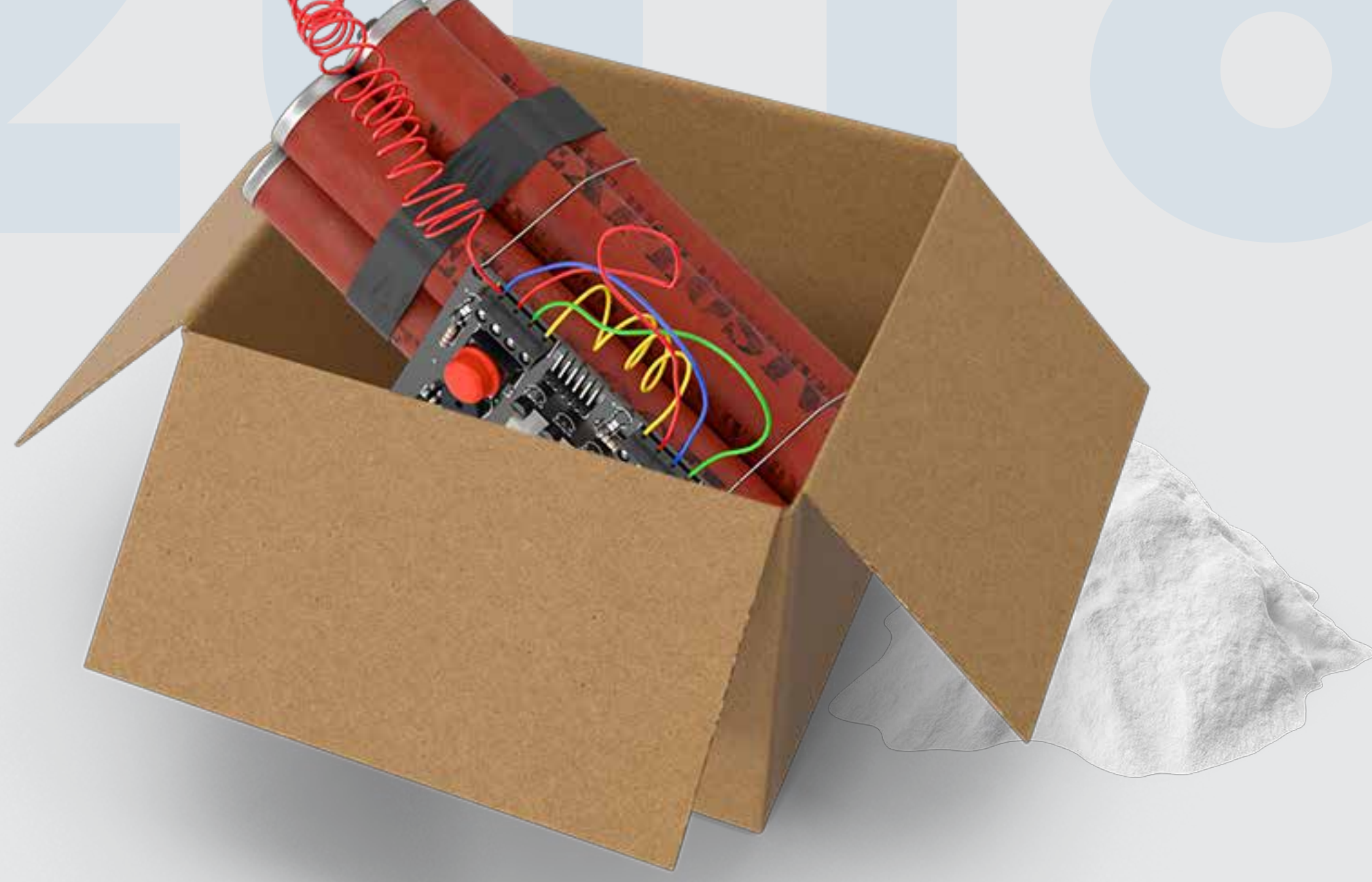


# EASY TO MAKE AND HARD TO SPOT

## MOST ORGANIZATIONS DON'T TAKE ADEQUATE PRECAUTIONS TO BLOCK MAIL THREATS



Half of companies surveyed don't screen incoming mail at all. Those that screen typically stop at visual inspection (69%) or X-ray (60%).

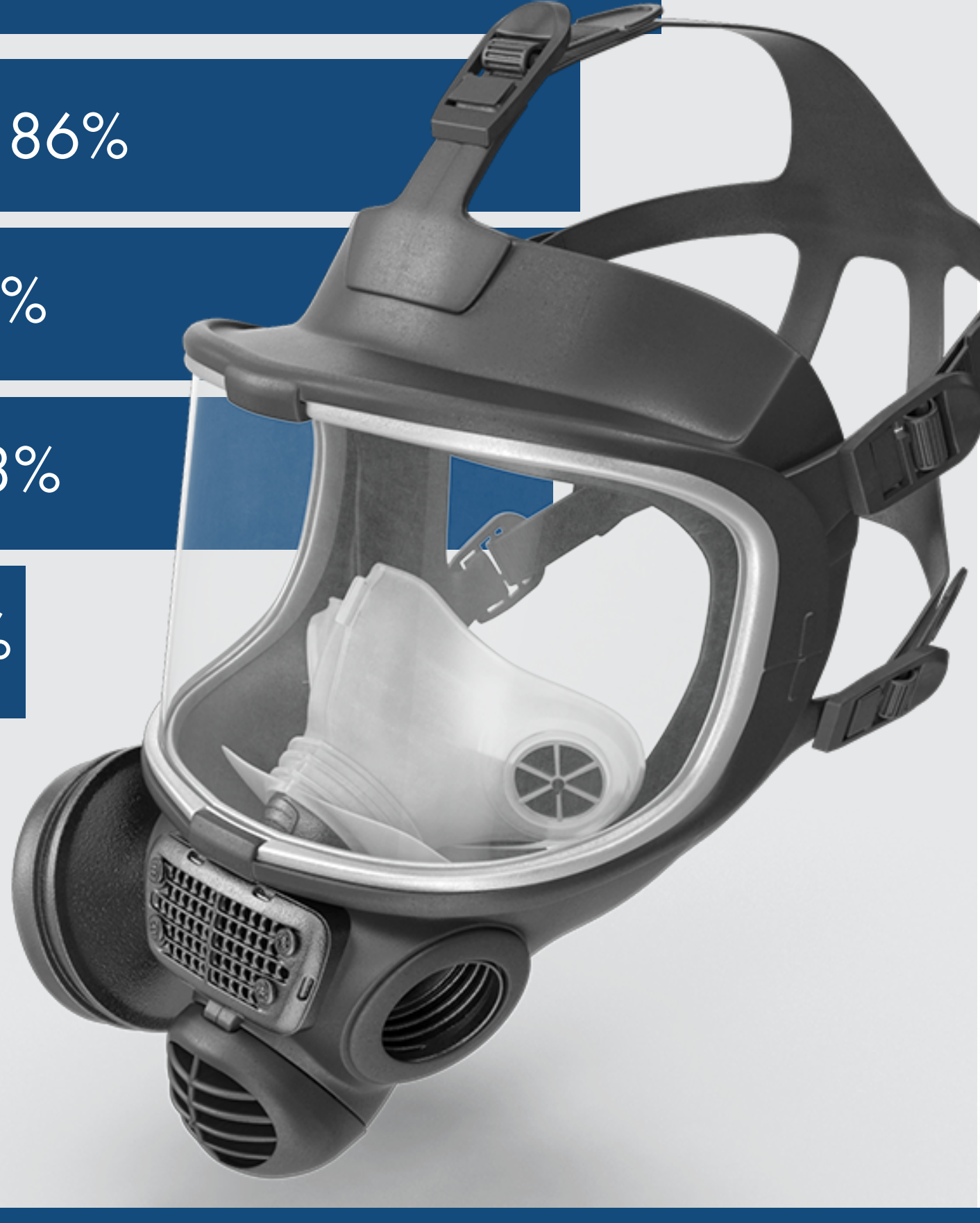

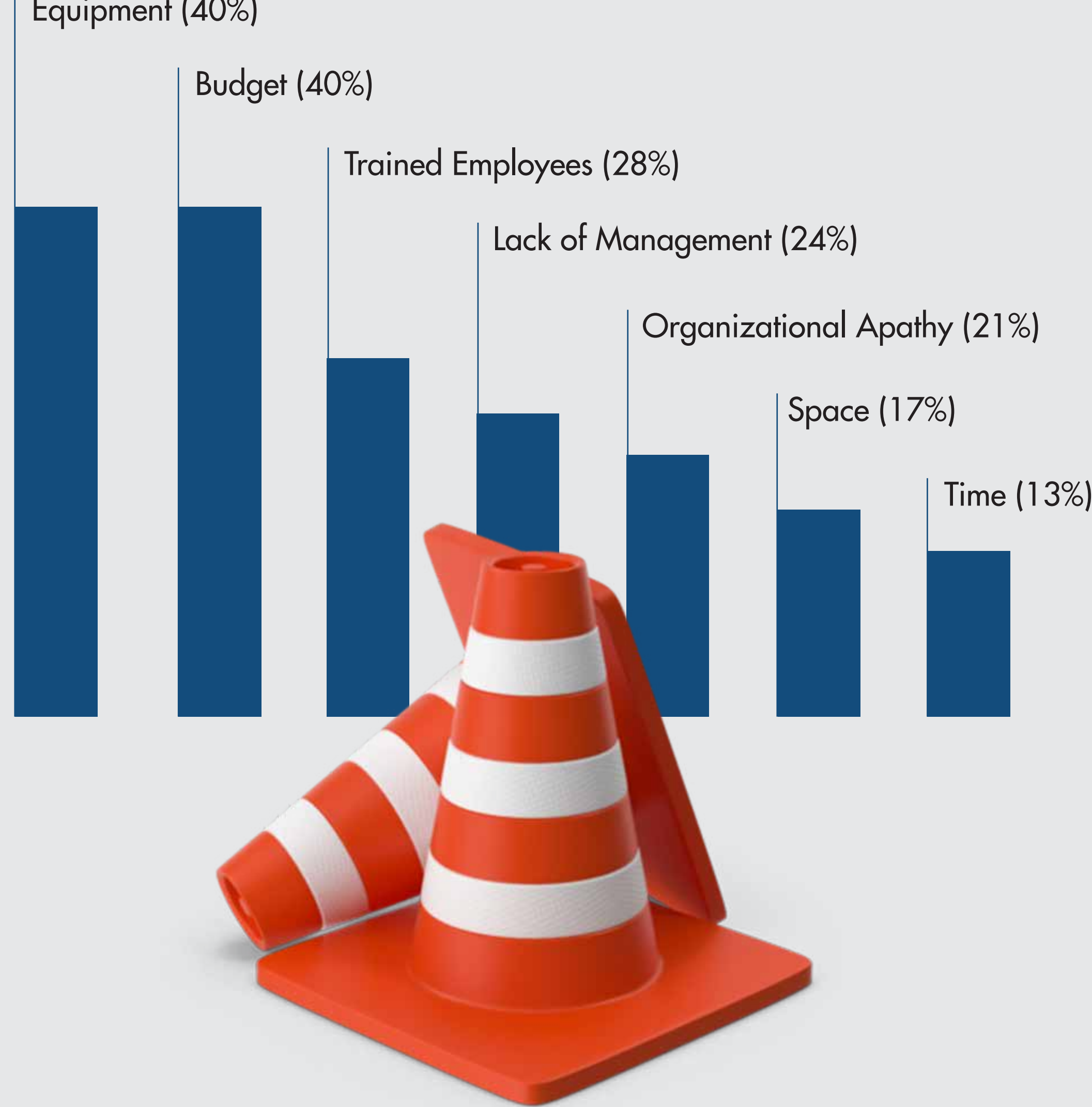
